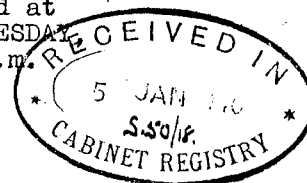

POSSIBLE GERMAN ACTION IN THE SPRING OF 1940.
(Previous reference: M.R.(40) 1st Meeting, Item 6).
