Thank you so much for your letter of the 2 Feb. which arrived this morning. I must say I am looking forward to hearing what the ex-Legionnaires say about Fallingbostal. I wonder if any of them remember anything about the POW Camps ?

I recently had some more information from the German authorities in Berlin, concerning the two graves in the town cemetery. They are as follows :

(A.) GAUSDAL, Amund Petterson.

born: 28.6.1923. Sundryloon. *Sykkyløen? (Geiranger)*
rank: Legionar.
died: 29.9.1941, Res. Lazarett, Bergen/Belsen.

(B.) JOHANSEN, Arne.

born: 17.4.1913. Svoloa (Narvik).
rank: Legionar.
died: 22.11.1941, Res. Lazarett, Bergen/Belsen.

It is interesting to note that at the time, there was a virulent outbreak of Typhus in the area. All those who were military personnel were quarantined in Belsen, so the above two most probably perished due to the disease.

Again, many thanks for your help, and I enclose a map of the barracks for reference.
