NORWEGIAN ARMY CHIEF ESCAPES DAGGER ATTACK

OSLO, Feb. 4.—(AP)—An attack last Tuesday on Maj. Quisling, Norwegian minister of defense, in which one or more of his assailants first tried to stab the minister, then threw pepper in his face and knocked him unconscious, was disclosed in a police statement tonight. He was not seriously hurt and was able to return to work the next day. A reward of \$900 has been offered for information leading to the arrest of the assailants.

When the minister went to his office to fetch some documents, the police statement said, he was suddenly set upon by one or more unidentified persons.

"On entering his private office which was in darkness, an attempt was made to stab the minister in the back with a knife," the police said. "He succeeded in evading the knife, but received a violent blow on the head and at the same time pepper was thrown in his face."
