I do not remember whether I have told you that I am going on a short visit to the United States in May, and my intention is then to try to make what I possibly can for the Armenian refugee question. I am therefore very anxious to see the various organisations and especially perhaps the prominent Armenians, who can be of special help for our cause. I shall have to attend a meeting in Cleveland, Ohio, between May 7th and 12th. It would therefore be most convenient to me to see the Armenians and the friends of Armenia just before or after that time. I write to you already now to ask you what you think ought to be done in order to make the best possible use of my short stay in the United States. Perhaps you may also bring the question before Nubar Pacha and ask his advice.

My book on Armenia is now being printed in English and German, and I hope these two editions will soon appear. I have not yet been able to find a French publisher willing to publish a French edition. I expect, however, this might be of importance. Could you give me any advice in this respect.

May I ask you to convey my kindest regards with my best wishes for the New Year to Nubar Pacha, and accept you yourself my hearty good wishes.
